Definition: The Board of Directors values their employees and does not want to place them in compromising situations with members. Therefore, the Board has established the following guidelines regarding the delivery of packages to GLC buildings.

Purpose: The purpose of this policy is to clearly establish guidelines for members regarding the delivery of members' private packages, requiring a signature to any GLC building.

Policy: Due to liability concerns for employees and the organization, no Glenhaven Lakes employee will sign for any members' packages, delivered by any carrier, to the office, clubhouse, or shop..

Whatcom County Fire District #18 is looking for people with a desire to serve. We are in need of committed Volunteer Firefighter/EMT's. We are a volunteer based fire department with a paid Fire Chief. We currently have 16 volunteers and 4 openings

We respond to medical emergencies, rescues, and fire related calls. If there's a problem, we handle it. When the tones go off, we respond from home to the station for our needed apparatus and equipment. From the station we then respond to wherever the call is.

Our volunteers come from a variety of backgrounds. Some of us are career firefighters, electricians, mechanics, carpenters, Oil operators, construction workers, and engineers just to name a few. It is our wide range of backgrounds that make us such a unique department. We are males, females, vary in age, and the majority of us have full time jobs and families.

Being a Volunteer Firefighter/EMT means a lot of things. It means that you are there for your neighbors and community members at their darkest times. We see and handle a lot, but we are there for each other. Being a Volunteer means getting up in the middle of the night when the pager goes off because someone in your community is in need. It means leaving family events at a moment's notice to respond to the call. It means leaving home right when dinner is ready because someone is having the worst day of their life. Choosing to be a Volunteer in your community is one of the most rewarding sacrifices that you can make. And we need you.

All trainings, equipment, and uniforms are paid for by the department. You will have access to our department gym and with time, will get to drive the giant red truck! We train every single week on Tuesday at 7:00 pm. Applicants are required to observe 4 trainings before any interview process begins. So stop by and see if the challenge is for you!
