

# Policy 18-10-01

## Policy Statement

In interests of safety and health and to ensure a safe environment for members, tenants and guests of Glenhaven Lakes Club, Inc. ("Association"), the Association prohibits the wearing, transporting, storage, or presence of firearms or other dangerous weapons in the common areas and common facilities of the Association. Any member, guest or invitee who violates this policy may be removed from the property and reported to police authorities. Possession of a valid concealed weapons permit authorized by the State of Washington is not an exemption under this policy.

## Definition

Firearms or other dangerous weapons mean:

- any device from which a projectile may be fired by an explosive
- any simulated firearm operated by gas or compressed air
- any spring blade knife
- any knife which opens or is ejected open by an outward, downward thrust or movement

## Exemptions

This policy does not apply to:

- any law enforcement personnel engaged in official duties
- any security personnel engaged in official duties
- any person engaged in military activities sponsored by the federal or state government, while engaged in official duties

## Notification

"No Firearms or other Dangerous Weapons" signs shall be conspicuously posted within all common areas and common facilities. These signs will clearly indicate that firearms and other weapons are not to be carried onto the Association's common areas or common facilities.

## Reporting

Association staff or personnel will request any member, tenant, guest, licensee or visitor found in possession of a firearm or other dangerous weapon to leave the common area or common facilities and local law enforcement authorities will be notified promptly.
